



Marcelo Marzocchini is an Electronics Engineer graduated from National University of La Plata (Sábato Award in 1993) and has a Master degree in Government Economics from Universidad Torcuato Di Tella.

He specializes in industrial and technological policies, international trade and economic integration. He has a long career in both, public and private sector.

At present he is the Operations Director of the National Institute of Industrial Technology (INTI).
